

Taekwondo studio reopens at new location in Hamilton

HAMILTON — A taekwondo studio with a 16-year history in Mercer County reopened at its new location on Flock Road last weekend.

It wasn't much of a move — E.Y. Martial Arts & Self-Defense Concepts just shifted from one space in the University Plaza Shopping Center to another. But the business has added roughly 500 square feet of space, room the growing business sorely needed.

“We've grown over the past years, and it was a better location for us and we seem to be getting a lot more traffic,” said Christina Yuncza, whose husband, Ed, owns and operates the business.

Ed Yuncza, is a 5th Degree Black Belt, the studio's head instructor and the author of “Sport Karate Point Sparring.”

He teaches taekwondo students “anywhere from age 3 to 99,” Christina Yuncza said.

E.Y. Martial Arts stayed open through the renovation of its new space, which required some painting and construction.
